Our program for the evening was on 'TEMPLAR - THE SUPERFINE SMALL CAR. Rich Jandrey introduced Dave Buehler who is the largest collector of Templar cars in the world.

Dave now shows six of his thirteen car collection in the original building that manufactured the Templar car which is located at 13000 Athens Avenue in Lakewood.

The Templar name started with six men who were Masons. The Masons insignia is the Templar knight which is the hood emblem on each car. The Templar in the day was a high end car producing 6, 500 cars during 1916-1924. 150 cars were made in 1918. Templar produced eleven different models costing from \$2,685 to \$3,500. Only in 1921 were changes made in production.

Dave's presentation ended with a short movie on the history of the Templar car and invited the club to his Templar building which will be open to the public on May 7, 2011.

Ginnie Herrmann read the minutes from the meeting of March 18, 2011. A correction was made on the V-8 Meet being held in New York not Pennsylvania as read. The minutes were accepted as read by Craig Gorris and seconded by Bill Royer.
